The **OneCity Trust** is pleased to announce that its main grant funding programme for 2023 is now open for applications seeking funding for equality and social inclusion projects, who meet **one or more** of the following priorities.

- SOCIAL INCLUSION
- CULTURAL & COMMUNITY BRIDGING
- CIVIC INCLUSION

The deadline for applications is **5pm, Friday 5 May 2023**, and projects should commence on **31 July 2023** and run for up to one year. Please note a shorter length project will also be considered.

Funding Criteria

- you must be a registered, Scottish charity or constituted organisation.
- you must have been operational for at least one year.
- you must be based in Edinburgh and focussing your work on the city.
- you must supply a copy of your latest, signed annual accounts.
- you must supply evidence of a bank account in the organisations name.
- your charity's annual income, ideally should be less than £500,000 per year (but exceeding this amount may be considered), and
- you must also acknowledge the source of your OneCity Trust funding at every opportunity.

We are pleased to note that we continue our partnership with Travis Perkins Managed Services and the City of Edinburgh Council. This is a Community Benefit Legacy fund offered to the Council by Travis Perkins Managed Services as part of a major contract and is managed through the One City Trust. This year, we are also pleased to announce that we have legacy funding partnerships in place with OpenView Security Solutions Ltd, NRS Healthcare, NSL Services, CCG (Scotland) Ltd, Robertson Group, Skanska and CGI UK Ltd.

Overall, the Trust intends to process 10 - 17 grants of between £5,000 and £10,000 each.
