**Community Response, Recovery and Resilience Fund (RRR Fund)** In partnership with the National Emergencies Trust, Foundation Scotland is delivering the RRR Fund to help support local charities and grassroots organisations across Scotland to respond to coronavirus and recover from its impact. Constituted community groups and charities can apply at any time for funds up to a maximum of £5000 (minimum is £1000). Find out more here.

Key to Choice has reopened. The number of homes advertised each week will be limited at first and increase slowly to make sure that it remains as safe as possible for everyone. In accordance with the Scottish Government guidance for social landlords during the coronavirus outbreak, the initial focus will be to house those applicants who have been statutorily assessed as homeless and/or have an extreme housing need.

Stair cleaning has restarted after being stopped for a short time, apart from emergency and sheltered housing cleaning, due to coronavirus. This was done because it was vital to help prevent the spread of the illness and protect residents and staff. As part of addressing cleaning that has not taken place, the stair cleaning teams have been deck scrubbing/deep cleaning all stairs to help bring them back up to a satisfactory standard, at no extra charge to residents or the Council. This cleaning is above the standard specification in the contract carried out as part of the regular rota cleans.
