Income Advice Service

Are you a City of Edinburgh Council tenant and find you don't have enough money or benefit problems are affecting your payment of rent? The Income Advice Service is available for all council tenants whether you are in or out of work. The service can provide advice and assistance to make claims and also see what further help is available for you, including:

- Housing Benefit and Council Tax Reduction;
- Housing Costs as part of your Universal Credit;
- Extra help to pay rent Discretionary Housing Payments;
- Emergency crisis / foodbank vouchers;
- Managing your money, changes to your household budget and other expenses e.g. fuel costs and
- Other welfare benefits Pension Credits, Disability Benefits etc.
