OneCity Trust Grant Programme

Does your tenants' group involve City of Edinburgh Council tenants? Would you be interested in applying for a grant for a project?

If you answered yes to both of these questions, then you will certainly be interested in the OneCity Trust Grant Programme. The OneCity Trust is running a grants programme, where funding is available to constituted groups and small charities in the city. Two sizes of grant are available: larger grants of between £5,000 and £10,000, and also small grants of up to £2,000. This year, the Trust is particularly interested in applications from tenants' groups which involve City of Edinburgh Council tenants. The deadline for the main grant application is **Friday 29**th **April 2016**, so if you would like help in putting together an application, please phone Justine Bradd at ETF's office on 0131 475 2509 or email <u>justine@edinburghtenants.org.uk</u>. Priority will be given to tenants' groups who are submitting applications for the main grants of £5,000 and £10,000. Small grant funds can be applied for throughout the year.
