City of Edinburgh Council Rent Consultation

Last year tenants told the City of Edinburgh Council they wanted them to build more homes, make homes cheaper to manage and provide services that help them to reduce costs. In January 2016 the Council agreed a plan to invest in homes and services that will help tenants spend less. The plan is to deliver all these money saving improvements by 2020 and keep rents affordable. This is your opportunity to get involved and have your say on the five year plan, whether you want to speed up improvements or slow them down and what else is affecting your cost of living.
